



**BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR FISCAL 2022  
EMERGENCY EXPENDITURE**

**WHEREAS**, on this day came for consideration by the Commissioners Court of Grayson County, the matter of amending the budget for Fiscal 2022 for Precinct 4 of Grayson County, Texas in accordance with Local Government Code 111.010, for emergency expenditures which are unusual and unforeseen as related to the Sherwood Shores tornado of March 21, 2022;

**WHEREAS**, after due consideration by the Court, it is ordered that for the fiscal year 2022, that the Precinct 4 Operating Expenses be increased up to \$50,000 from fund balance for purposes of the emergency expenditures related to the Sherwood Shores tornado of March 21, 2022;

Adopted this the 19th day of April, 2022, at a regular meeting of the Grayson County Commissioners Court and to be filed in the County Clerk's records to become part of the fiscal 2022 adopted budget of Grayson County.

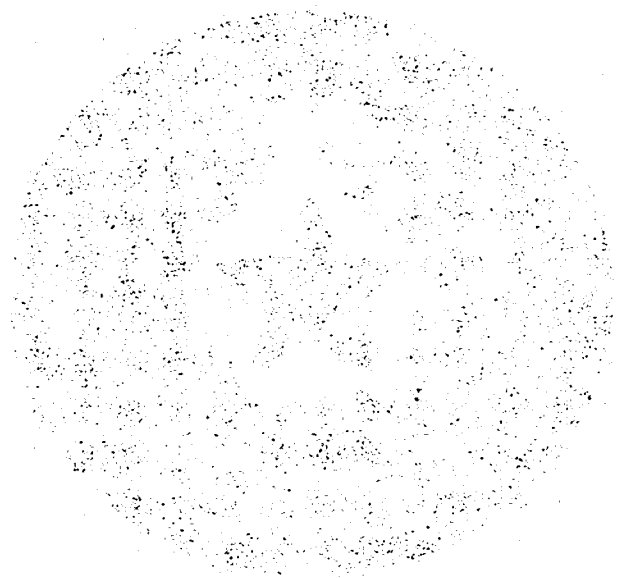
