

Justice Court Pct. 4 Policy for Modifying an Emergency Protective Order (EPO)

Question: What if I am a victim who wants to modify or terminate the Emergency Protective Order?

Answer:

1. The party requesting the modification or termination of the Emergency Protection Order can file their *Motion to Modify or Terminate the Emergency Protection Order* via email to JP4@co.grayson.tx.us, mail to P.O. Box 1964 in Van Alstyne, TX 75495, or bring in person to 117 S Main Dr. in Van Alstyne, TX 75495.
2. A copy of the motion then needs to be sent by the party filing the motion or request to all interested parties for the case or their attorneys. Interested parties include the defendant's attorney and the District Attorney assigned to the matter.
3. The person filing the motion then must file a *Request for a hearing date* via email to JP4@co.grayson.tx.us, with the State of Texas cc'd (DA's office), and counsel for the defendant cc'd.

Question: What if I am a defendant who wants to modify or terminate the Emergency Protective Order?

Answer: Contact your court appointed attorney or private attorney.

WARNING – At no point in this process should the victim and defendant for the EPO be in contact with each other in any form for any reason, as this is a violation of the EPO.
