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Effective January 1, 2021 Texas Administrative Code, Title 25, Chapter 265, Subchapter L states that **all** Class A, Class B, and Class C pools and spas shall be maintained under the supervision and direction of a properly trained and certified operator.

Operator training and certification can be obtained by completion of one of the following courses or their equivalent:

- The NRPA, "Aquatic Facility Operator;"
- The PHTA, "Certified Pool Operator,"
- The ASPSA, "Licensed Aquatic Facility Technician;"
- Or an equivalent course which requires testing and provides certification that is approved by the local regulatory authority.

The Grayson County Health Department will **not** issue a Swimming Pool Permit and/or Spa Permit unless the above certification is completed and can be verified by an inspector.
