To: The District Clerk , Grayson County, Texas,

(1) Pursuant to the authority of VTCA Government Code § 74.091 et. seq; The Texas Constitution and the inherent authority of the Courts, the following Administrative Order is issued this 15th Day of September, 2008 and directed to the District Clerk of Grayson County, Texas, its deputies and employees.


(2) It is ordered that all felony criminal cases filed in the District Courts of Grayson County, Texas be filed according the first letter of the last name of the defendant.

- (a) Defendant's with the last name beginning with the letters A through H shall be filed in the 15th District Court.
- (b) Defendant's with the last name beginning with the letters I through N shall be filed in the 59th District Court.
- (c) Defendant's with the last name beginning with the letters O through Z shall be filed in the 397th District Court.

Exceptions will not be made for Co-Defendant cases pending in different Courts.

(3) Upon written request from the Judges of the 15th, 59th, 336th or 397th District Court, the District Clerk shall provide documentation or other evidence that this order is being complied with. The District Clerk will communicate with the Administrative Judge of the District Courts for further instruction should a question arise regarding the filing and docketing of a case.

This Order shall be enforceable by contempt, shall be served personally upon the District Clerk, filed among the records of the District Clerk of Grayson County, Texas. A copy of this Order along with the executed return shall be returned to the Administrative Judge of the District Courts.
