- Provides weekly education programs to residents that include hygiene, tobacco, alcohol awareness, sexually transmitted diseases, and other topics appropriate for the residents.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE INTERVENTION PROGRAMS

- Provided by Licensed Professional Counselors
- Group size of 6-8 juveniles
- 12 Step program providing a comprehensive substance abuse education and recovery program for adolescents while they are residing at the Grayson County Boot Camp.
- Treatment Team Meetings held monthly to assess progress

SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

- Provides classes in humanities including: music, art and drama.

OPTIONAL RELIGIOUS SERVICES

- Provided bi-weekly by area volunteers of Non-Denominational and Catholic affiliations.

DISCIPLINE

Discipline Management Techniques

- Discipline will be designed to correct misconduct and to encourage adherence by all cadets to their responsibilities as a citizen of the school community. Disciplinary action will draw upon the professional judgment of the Drill Instructor (DI) and on a range of discipline management techniques.
- Disciplinary problems may be addressed in any of the following ways:
- Counseling by teachers, administrative personnel or drill instructors.
- Oral correction
- EMI—Extra Military Instruction
- Disciplinary Review Boards provide due process hearing for serious or consistent misbehavior

EDUCATION

Education is the key to success.

- All teaching staff Certified Teachers.
- Provided by Sherman Independent School District
- Class size 1 teacher to 10 students.
- Special Education services provided with assigned Educational Diagnostician.
- All students are Pre and Post tested to measure academic performance utilizing the STAR diagnostic instrument.
- Computers in each classroom.
- Academic enrichment and recommendation provided through "Plato", a computer based educational support system.

JOB BOOK (Life Skills)

- The object of the Job Book is designed to help individuals learn skills to assist them in making better life choices and become productive members of a classroom and community.
- Cadets will be required to participate in job book assignments on a daily basis.

SEX OFFENDER TREATMENT PROGRAM

- Provided by Licensed Sex Offender Treatment Providers
- Intensive program using Pathways curriculum with goal of transitioning juvenile into outpatient sex offender treatment pending successful completion of inpatient program
- Group meetings twice weekly
- Individual sessions bi-monthly
- Treatment Team Meetings held monthly to assess progress

ANGER MANAGEMENT GROUP

- Provided by Case Management Staff
- The 8-week Strategies for Anger Management Program provides a safe environment for honest expression of personal and family issues. The group provides support, accountability and peer feedback.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE EDUCATION GROUP

- Conducted by Licensed Substance Abuse Counselors
- Group size of 8 to 10 juveniles
- Goal is to increase their knowledge of how substance abuse has affected their lives and the people they associate with.
- Juveniles are required to do homework on a weekly basis.

CASE MANAGEMENT

- Intensive Case Management Provided
- All case managers certified JDO, JCO, JPO
- Caseloads of 1:12.
- Formulate individual case plans that articulate goals and objectives for the juvenile and meet TJPC Case management standards
- Certified Prevention Specialist
- Monitors physical concerns
- Conducts parent education
- Conduct weekly review boards to monitor juveniles' progress and contact JPO's
- Facilitate MRT groups
- Facilitate Anger Management Groups

MORAL RECONATION THERAPY (MRT)

Moral Reconciliation Therapy is a step-by-step treatment strategy designed to enhance self-image, promote growth of a positive, productive identity and facilitate the development of a higher stages of moral reasoning. Reconciliation relates to how one consciously makes decisions. MRT represents a redirecting of decision-making from higher stages of moral reasoning.
