**ORDER OF
ADJUDICATION AND DISPOSITION**

On the ____ day of _____, 2003, came on to be heard the above cause and came Petitioner, represented by a Prosecuting Attorney; the child, in person and represented by @, attorney; and ^, parent or guardian of said child; and _____ was duly appointed as Guardian Ad Litem, and all parties announced ready for the hearing.

The parties were advised about the allegations made against the child, and nature and possible consequences of the proceedings, the child's privilege against self-incrimination, the child's right to trial and confrontation of witnesses and the child's right to trial by jury, all of which rights were waived by the child and the child's attorney.

The Court then proceeded to consider the pleadings, evidence, or arguments of counsel, and the Court finds beyond a reasonable doubt that the child, who was born on the ____ day of _____, 19__, did engage in delinquent conduct in that:

COUNT I

on or about the ____ day of _____, 20__, in the County of Grayson, State of Texas, *, did then and there

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that * is a child who did engage in delinquent conduct. The Court closed the adjudication hearing.

On the ____ day of _____, 2003, all parties being present, the Court reconvened for the disposition hearing and after reviewing the evidence finds that, because the child is in need of rehabilitation and for the protection of the public and of the child, a disposition must be made.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that * is hereby placed on probation in the custody of ^ for a period of __ months with placement at the Grayson County Department of Juvenile Services until successful completion of the Boot Camp Program or until further orders of this Court, with Conditions of Probation attached hereto and made a part of this Order for all purposes.

The Court finds that * has the following educational needs: to obtain a high school diploma or GED equivalency.

The disposition ordered herein addresses * 's educational needs in the following manner: By attending _____ Independent School District or other accredited school and following all rules and regulations of said school.

The Court finds ^ is the person responsible for supporting *. After notice, ^ was given a reasonable opportunity to be heard concerning their ability to pay a monthly probation fee of \$15.00 for the __ months * is on probation.

The Court finds ^ is able to pay a monthly probation fee of \$15.00. It is hereby ordered that ^ make monthly probation fee payments in the amount of \$15.00 to Grayson County Juvenile Probation Department for __ months beginning _____.

The Court finds that it is in the best interest of the child for the child to be placed outside of his or her home for the reasons state in Exhibit A incorporated herein. The Court further finds that the child has been removed from his or her home and the court approves the removal.

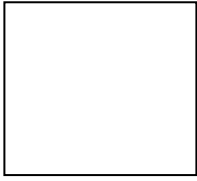
The Court finds that reasonable efforts have been made to prevent or eliminate the need for the child to be removed from his or her home and to make it possible for the child to return to his or her home as reference in Exhibit B incorporated hrein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Grayson County Juvenile Probation Department be responsible for the child's care and placement.

The Respondent and parties were informed in open Court of the right to appeal pursuant to Chapter 56, Texas Family Code.
