

Parent Empowerment Class

Curriculum based on SAMHSA approved parenting class curriculums Nurturing Parenting and Parenting Wisely, along with RealCare Babies®

Studies show that these programs improve parenting attitudes, knowledge, beliefs, and skills, and strengthen family relationships and interactions. These programs reduce recidivism of child abuse and neglect, child behavior problems, and delinquency and substance abuse among adolescents.

Nurturing Parenting programs are used by the Departments of Army and Navy to enhance parenting skills on bases worldwide. Parenting Wisely curriculum was named exemplary by the office of Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention. Both programs are recognized by the National Registry for Evidence-based Parenting Programs (NREPP) for the prevention and treatment of child abuse and neglect.
