OSSF Homeowner Maintenance Classes

Grayson County has adopted new rules outlining the training and maintenance report submittal requirements for homeowners that wish to maintain their own on-site sewage facility (OSSF), if it is an aerobic treatment unit (ATU) with secondary treatment. In Grayson County, with the appropriate training, homeowners may be allowed to maintain their own system. This exemption is only for single-family residences. Commercial, speculative residential or multifamily properties do not qualify. Training classes that may be used to fulfill OSSF Homeowner Maintenance requirements in accordance with County and State law shall be approved by Grayson County and the Texas Commission Environmental Quality.
