Grayson County obtained a new voting system in 2019 from Election Systems & Software (ES&S). The new voting system includes ExpressVote ballot marking devices and DS200 digital scan precinct tabulators available at every polling location. The system is federally and state certified. This hybrid system allows for the convenience and accuracy of electronic voting, as well as the security of an auditable paper ballot that can be used for manual recounts.

Using the new system is simple and easy. You will mark the selections, print, review and scan the ballot card as demonstrated below.



VOTE

At check-in you will receive a blank ballot. Insert this ballot into any ExpressVote BMD. Follow instructions on the screen for making your selections. Poll workers will be available if you need assistance.

REVIEW

When prompted, print your ballot. Carefully review all the selections printed on the card to be sure it accurately reflects your choices.





SCAN

You MUST then scan your ballot into the DS200 to cast your vote. Do NOT leave the polling location with your ballot.
