HOLIDAY LIGHT BYLAWS

The Grayson County Holiday Lights community project was founded in 2000 with grants from the Smith Foundation and The Mayor Foundation with stipulations that the displays would always be open to the public for touring at no charge and that there would be no business/commercial displays or advertising permitted. Location of the displays/tour to be at Loy Lake Park.

- Donations only. No per person/car charges. (As mandated by the Smith and Mayor foundations.)
- No commercial displays accepted.
- Do not rent/lease displays and allow sponsor signs.
- Do not allow election signs in the Park or electioneering at the donation booth.
- Companies can hand out one (1) page brochures on the nights they are manning the donation booth.
- Due to parking limitations, concession stands or other activities that slow the traffic flow are not allowed.
- Volunteers should be limited to six (6) people per shift, rotating with two (2) outside working donations.
- Under the age of 16 volunteers at the donation booth shall be accompanied by an adult over 21.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed.
- Donations are for Holiday Lights. A civic or non-profit organization cannot receive a share of the nightly donations.
