

RESOLUTION 485

A RESOLUTION ORDERING THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF WHITEWRIGHT, GRAYSON AND FANNIN COUNTY, TEXAS TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY MAY 4^{TH} , 2024, JOINTLY WITH WHITEWRIGHT INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, GRAYSON AND FANNIN COUNTY, TEXAS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 O'CLOCK A.M. AND 7:00 O'CLOCK P.M., BY THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF WHITEWRIGHT, GRAYSON AND FANNIN COUNTY, TEXAS WITH THE EARLY VOTING FOR THE CITY OF WHITEWRIGHT BEING CONDUCTED IN THE CITY HALL FROM THE 22^{ND} DAY OF APRIL, 2024 THROUGH THE 26^{TH} DAY OF APRIL, 2024. MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8:00 O'CLOCK A.M. AND 5:00 O'CLOCK P.M., OFFICE HOURS WILL BE 7:00 O'CLOCK A.M. TO 7:00 O'CLOCK P.M. ON THE 29^{TH} , DAY OF APRIL, 2024 AND 30^{TH} DAY OF APRIL, 2024 FOR SAID PURPOSES OF ELECTING COUNCILMEMBERS PLACE 4 AND MAYOR BEING OF SAID CITY, TO SERVE AS MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE ENSUING TWO (2) YEARS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITEWRIGHT:

Section 1. That a regular municipal election of the City of Whitewright, Grayson and Fannin County, Texas be held by the qualified voters of the City of Whitewright, Grayson and Fannin County, Texas on Saturday, May 4th, 2024 jointly with Whitewright Independent School District between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 7:00 o'clock p.m. for the purpose of electing Place 4 and Mayor of the City Council for two (2) year terms of the City of Whitewright.

Section 2. That the polling places and election officials of such election shall be as follows:

<u>Section 3.</u> The Presiding Judge shall designate and appoint two (2) competent clerks for such respective polling places and voting booths as may be required for the efficient conduct of said election.

Section 4. That early voting for the election described in Section 1, above shall be conducted under the direction of the Grayson County Election Administration and their deputies as ordered in separate order here from, beginning on the 22nd day of April, 2024 through the 26th day of April, 2024 Monday through Friday, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 5:00 o'clock p.m., office hours will be 7:00 o'clock a.m. to 7:00 o'clock p.m. on April 29th, 2024 and April 30th, 2024

Section 5. That the polling place and election officials for early voting of said election shall be as follow:

<u>Section 6.</u> That the mailing address to which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail may be sent to is Grayson County Election Administration as follows:

Section 7. There is hereby created an early voting ballot board, which consists of the presiding judge, and three (3) clerks to be appointed by the said presiding judge. The early voting ballot board shall carry out the duties enumerated in Chapter 87 of the Election Code of the State of Texas.

Such election shall be held in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas governing general and municipal elections, insofar as the same may be applicable, and with the provision of the Ordinances of the City of Whitewright, wherein such laws and ordinances do not conflict with the above described Order.

Section 9. The City Secretary of the City of Whitewright is hereby directed and instructed to post a properly executed Notice of Election pursuant to this Order of Election, signed by the Mayor of the City of Whitewright and attested by the City Secretary, on the front window provided for notices at the City Hall, at the polling place designated above at least twenty-one (21) days before the election; further, a properly executed copy of such Notice of Election shall be published at least one time not more than thirty (30) days nor less than ten (10) days before the elections in at least one daily newspaper. Published in the City's Official paper the Herald Democrat, and a copy of the notice shall be filed with the City Secretary of the City of Whitewright, together with the posting officer's return and the newspaper certificate of publication.

<u>Section 10.</u> The pay of the judge and clerks of said election is hereby authorized and established as follows: \$12.00 per hour for judge and \$10.00 per hour for two (2) clerks. The City of Whitewright and Whitewright Independent School District will respectfully share the cost of said workers if the workers are qualified in both voting districts.
