

## GRAYSON COUNTY JUVENILE BOARD MINUTES

A meeting of the Juvenile Board of Grayson County was held on Thursday, January 8, 2026 at 12:00 pm in the Department of Juvenile Services training room, 200 S. Crockett, Sherman, TX 75090.

I. Call to Order and Declaration of Quorum: A quorum was declared at 12:03pm by Judge Jim Fallon, Chairman. Also attending were Judge Bruce Dawsey, Judge Larry Phillips, Judge Brian Gary, & Judge Rick Dunn. Assistant Chief LaTonya Moore, and Chief Greg Sumpter, & Suzette Smith were also present.

### II. Action Items:

- a. Discuss position of Juvenile Services Chief Juvenile Probation Officer. Juvenile Board entered executive session at 12:04.
- b. Pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.074, the Juvenile Board reserves the right to potentially meeting in executive session to discuss deliberations about personnel matters.

Executive session ended at 12:15p.

- c. Consider and take possible action with regard to matters discussed in executive session.

A motion was made by Judge Larry Phillips to post the Chief Probation Officer position with a salary range of 120,000-140,000. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Judge Brian Gary. All in favor.

A motion was made by Judge Larry Phillips to give Judge Jim Fallon the authority to appoint an interim Chief Juvenile Probation officer. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Judge Brian Gary. All in favor.

At 12:22pm a motion was made by Judge Fallon to move to adjourn, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Judge Phillips. All in favor. 5-0 vote.
