Beginning March 19, 2020 until April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020, all Justice of the Peace Courts in Grayson County will be closed to public interaction. This is due to the continued threat of COVID 19.


We have already suspended all non-essential criminal and civil case, as suggested by the Supreme Court of Texas and the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals. Those cases will be reset for a later date and all litigants will be notified of the new court date.

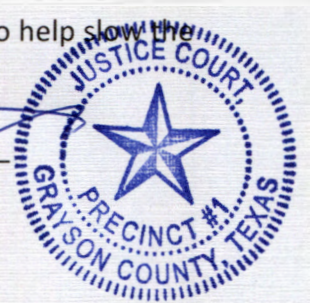
Although the Offices will be closed, we will still be working. We will still be accepting any case filings through Mail and E-file.

If you have a current citation or criminal case pending, those cases have also been continued. You can call the office to check on the status and can also check the status of your case, on-line. Also at this time, any cases filed, will not have service performed, until such time that the statewide declaration has been lifted.
