


Grayson County Planning & Zoning Steps For Addressing, Platting, Lake Ray Roberts Zoning Application, Floodplain Permits, Mobile Home Rental Community Permits, Right-of- Way Permits

Grayson County does require the completion of a Development Certificate for construction, placement or remodel of a building. Emergency-911 addresses, new culvert installations and floodplain determinations are processed in conjunction with the Development Certificate.

Within one day of submitting the Development Certificate for an E911 Address, the applicant will need to physically mark the driveway entrance location with a stake with their last name written on it. The Precinct Foreman will determine if a culvert is needed. Applicant will need to install the correct size culvert and will need to notify the Precinct Foreman that it is installed. Once the Precinct Foreman completes their final inspection of the driveway entrance, an address number will be assigned. Failure to mark the driveway entrance will result in a re-inspection fee of **\$100.00**.
