

If you are interested in serving the community by registering voters, we encourage you to join our team of volunteers. Volunteer Deputy Registrars are entrusted with the responsibility of officially registering voters.

Volunteer Deputy Registrars are appointed by the county voter registrar and charged with helping to increase voter registration in the state.

Acceptance of the duties of Volunteer Deputy Registrar places you in a position of trust and responsibility to the citizens you will register to vote.

## **Qualifications:**

- 1. Be at least 18 years old.
- 2. Be a United States citizen.
- 3. Not have been determined by a final judgement of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be
  - Totally mentally incapacitated, or
  - Partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote.
- 4. Never have been convicted of failing to deliver an application to voter registrar
- 5. Not have been finally convicted of a felony, or, if convicted must have

- Fully discharged the sentence, including any term of incarceration, parole, or supervision, or
- Been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disability to vote;
- 6. Not have been finally convicted of identity theft under Section 32.51 of the Penal Code; and
- 7. Be a Texas resident.
