Responds to and investigates complaints from county residents regarding animal safety code violations. Assist Sheriff's Department with animal control related incidents. Works with animal shelter to quarantine animals involved in human bite incidents. Picks up unwanted live animals and assists with injured animals in county areas not served by municipalities. Communicates and educates the general public in regards to animal safety codes. Performs other related duties as assigned.
Qualifications and Requirements:	Applicants must possess a high school diploma or a general equivalency diploma (GED). Selected candidate must also possess a valid Texas Department of State Health Services Animal Control Officer Basic Training certificate or shall obtain one within six (6) months of employment. Must have good communication skills; be computer literate and familiar with office equipment. Valid driver's license and automobile liability insurance coverage required. Must pass a criminal background check and drug screen. No tobacco use allowed.
