The court **FINDS** that, in this case, it is in the best interest of society and the Defendant to defer further proceedings without entering an adjudication of guilt. The court **ORDERS, ADJUDGES, AND DECREES** that Defendant shall be placed on probation for a period of _____ days (*not to exceed 180*).

The deferment cannot be offered to any driver holding a Commercial Driver's License.

The court:

- WAIVES** court costs because Defendant is indigent, lacks sufficient resources or income to pay the court costs, or was a child at the time of the offense.
- ORDERS** Defendant to pay court costs, in the amount indicated above in the following manner:
 - Defendant shall pay the court costs immediately and the deferment period will begin when the Judge signs this Order.
 - Defendant shall discharge \$_____ of the court costs by performing community service or attending a tutoring program, as specified by the court below:

The court **FINDS** that:

- Defendant owes no restitution in connection with the charged offense.
- Defendant owes restitution to a victim of the offense, and the Defendant is **ORDERED** to make restitution to _____, the victim of the offense, as specified by the court below.

The court **ORDERS** Defendant to comply with the following terms and conditions during the probation period:

- Do not commit any offense against the laws of the United States, the State of Texas, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, or another state.
- Complete a driving safety course approved The Texas Department of Licensing & Regulation. (www.tdlr.texas.gov/driver/driver.htm)
- Submit to a driving examination conducted by the Department of Public Safety in accordance with Transportation Code § 521.161(b)(2), regardless of whether you have previously completed a driving exam. Pay the \$10.00 examination fee.
- Complete an Anger Management class within the one hundred eighty (180) day deferment.
- Provide proof of paid insurance for six (6) months.
- Within ten (10) days after the deferment period ends, the Defendant shall contact the Court by phone (903-564-3550) for execution of the final disposition.

The court admonishes Defendant that full and complete compliance with this order will result in the dismissal of the charged offense.

If Defendant fails to comply with the court's order and/or receives another citation, the court will summon Defendant to a hearing. If Defendant fails to show good cause at the hearing for the failure to comply with this order, the court will issue a judgment of conviction and impose the fine assessed in the amount indicated above.
