



## Justice Court Pct. 4 Policy for Emergency Protective Order (EPO)

The Justice of the Peace, Pct. 4 Policy for modifying an Emergency Protection Order (EPO) is as follows:

1. The party requesting the modification or termination of the Emergency Protection Order can file their *Motion to Vacate Protective Order* via email to [JP4@co.grayson.tx.us](mailto:JP4@co.grayson.tx.us), mail to P.O. Box 1964 in Van Alstyne, TX 75495, or bring in person to 117 S Main Dr. in Van Alstyne, TX 75495.
2. A copy of the motion then needs to be sent by the party filing the motion or request to all interested parties for the case or their attorneys. Interested parties include the defendant's attorney and the District Attorney assigned to the matter.
3. The person filing the motion then must file a *Request for a hearing date* via email to [JP4@co.grayson.tx.us](mailto:JP4@co.grayson.tx.us), with the State of Texas cc'd (DA's office), and counsel for the defendant cc'd.

**WARNING – At no point in this process should the victim and defendant for the EPO be in contact with each other in any form for any reason, as this is a violation of the EPO.**
