I. Call to order.

Robert Brady called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

II. **Approval of Minutes of July 13, 2017, Board Meeting.**

On motion by B. Rasor, seconded by R. Hensarling the board unanimously approved the minutes from the July 13, 2017 board meeting.

III. Committee Reports

- a. R. Brady no reports to give on rail committee.
- b. B. Benton gave an update on the 289 route. They have mailed a proposed route to all landowners then will request for approval through the committee and then to TxDot for approval. It will be an estimated nine to twelve months before TxDot approval. It is said to be out of the county control on completion date that they are on TxDot time.
- c. B. Rasor no reports to give on special committee.
- d. S. Hinton reported on current events going on at the airport; the clean and crack fill is under way on the closed parallel runway. They will be doing a hard kill of the weeds within the next week and then the cleaning of the cracks will begin about a week after that. The resurfacing of Grayson Drive is proposed to be complete by the end of next week. S. Hinton also announced there has been a new Control Tower manager hired, Mack Ream, with 17 years of air traffic control experience and 14 years military

background. S. Hinton also wanted to thank U.S. Aviation and Lake Texoma Jet Center in their relief efforts after the hurricanes.

 - S. Hinton commented that Julie usually heads that up, but it is just report that is updated yearly for TxDot.
- b. Discuss and take possible action on short and long term leases.
 - J. Wimberly suggested on long term contracts for TAP and the board to come up with a framework for presenting leases to the board. He included that there are several different factors in determining terms; the length of term is based on investment, but there is a 40 year limit in the state of Texas.
- c. Discussion of Special Committee for reviewing leases and new business.
 - R. Hensarling suggested that it would be a better use of everyone's time not to have a subcommittee and bring all items directly to the board. However R. Brady suggested to also have the ability to call a meeting if one is needed, since we have decided to go to quarterly meetings.
