

**A RESOLUTION OF GRAYSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT  
OF THE STATE OF TEXAS ALLOWING FIREWORKS SALES ON  
CERTAIN HOLIDAYS**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas legislature allows the sale of fireworks during certain periods including Diwali, and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Texas Occupations Code, Section 2154.202(h), the dates allowed for such sales of fireworks are:

1. Diwali: October 30, 2024 through November 3, 2024.

**WHEREAS**, the Grayson County Commissioners Court seeks to permit, consistent with State law, the sale of fireworks during certain periods for New Year's Eve, Texas Independence Day, San Jacinto Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Diwali;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that Subject to any existing burn bans effective in 2024, the Grayson County Commissioners Court, pursuant to the Texas Occupations Code, Section 2154.202(h), allows the sale of fireworks during the following periods:

1. Diwali: October 30, 2024 through November 3, 2024.

Adopted this the 24th day of September, 2024, at a regular meeting of the Grayson County Commissioners Court.


