This packet is designed to guide prospective candidates through the process of filing for elected director on the Grayson Central Appraisal District Board of Directors.

All forms referenced in this packet are included.

Filing Period

Applications for a place on the ballot may be filed beginning Saturday, July 18, 2026, and must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, August 17, 2026.

Acknowledgement of Director's Duties

Pursuant to House Bill 148 (89th Legislature, Regular Session), effective September 1, 2025, an individual may not file an application for a place on the ballot for an elected position on an appraisal district board of directors unless the individual has signed an Acknowledgement of Director's Duties of Member of Appraisal District Board of Directors (Form 2-68).

Important: The acknowledgement form must be filed with the Chief Appraiser. This is separate from the candidate application, which must be filed with the Grayson County Elections Administrator.

Application for a Place on the Ballot

To become a candidate for the Grayson Central Appraisal District Board of Directors, you must file an Application for a Place on the Ballot (Form 2-49) with:

The Board of Directors positions are elected at-large by place. Candidates must indicate the specific place for which they are filing.

Filing Fee or Petition in Lieu of Filing Fee

Your Application for a Place on the Ballot must be accompanied by either:

- A filing fee of \$200.00; or
- A Petition in Lieu of Filing Fee (Form 2-51).

Section 6.032(d) of the Texas Tax Code requires a Petition in Lieu of Filing Fee to contain a minimum of 500 signatures from qualified voters.

The filing fee or petition must be submitted to the Grayson County Elections Administrator at the time the application is filed.

Withdrawal from Candidacy

A candidate may withdraw from the election and have their name omitted from the ballot by filing a notarized Certificate of Withdrawal (Form 2-66) with the Grayson County Elections Administrator.

The deadline for withdrawing is:

5:00 p.m., Monday, August 24, 2026

Filing Checklist

Between July 18, 2026, and 5:00 p.m. on August 17, 2026:

- File an Acknowledgement of Director's Duties of Member of Appraisal District Board of Directors (Form 2-68) with the Chief Appraiser of the Grayson Central Appraisal District.
- File an Application for a Place on the Ballot (Form 2-49) with the Grayson County Elections Administrator.
- Submit either:
 - A \$200.00 filing fee; or
 - A Petition in Lieu of Filing Fee (Form 2-51) containing at least 500 valid signatures.

If you later decide to withdraw:

- File a notarized Certificate of Withdrawal (Form 2-66) with the Grayson County Elections Administrator no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 24, 2026.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF DUTIES OF MEMBER OF APPRAISAL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS

I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understand the duties of a member of the board of directors of an appraisal district. I understand that the statutory responsibilities include:

- (1) establishing the appraisal district office;
- (2) hiring a chief appraiser;
- (3) adopting the appraisal district's annual operating budget after filing notice and holding a public hearing;
- (4) adopting a new budget if voting taxing units disapprove of the initial budget;
- (5) determining whether to remove members of the appraisal review board if the board of directors of the appraisal district is the appointing authority and potential grounds for removal arise;
- (6) notifying voting taxing units of any vacancy in an appointive position on the board and electing a replacement from submitted nominees;
- (7) appointing a person to fill a vacancy in an elective position on the board;
- (8) electing a chairman and a secretary of the board at the first meeting each year;
- (9) holding board meetings at least quarterly;
- (10) developing and implementing policies regarding reasonable access to the board;
- (11) preparing information describing the board's functions and complaint procedures and making that information available to the public and to participating taxing units;
- (12) notifying parties to a complaint filed with the board of the status of the complaint, unless otherwise provided;
- (13) in populous counties, appointing a taxpayer liaison officer and deputy taxpayer liaison officers;
- (14) annually evaluating the performance of the taxpayer liaison officer and any deputy taxpayer liaison officers, including reviewing the timeliness of complaint resolution;
- (15) referring matters investigated by a taxpayer liaison officer relating to the appraisal review board's conduct to the local administrative district judge with a recommendation;
- (16) developing a biennial written plan for the periodic reappraisal of all property in the appraisal district, filing notice and holding a public hearing on the plan, approving the plan, and distributing copies of the plan to participating taxing units and the comptroller;
- (17) making agreements with newly formed taxing units on an estimated budget allocation for that taxing unit;
- (18) having an annual financial audit prepared by an independent certified public accountant, delivering a copy of the audit to each voting taxing unit, and making the audit available for inspection at the appraisal district office;
- (19) designating the appraisal district depository biennially;
- (20) receiving resolutions from voting taxing units disapproving of board actions;

- (21) adhering to local government code requirements for purchasing and entering into contracts;
- (22) providing advice and consent to the chief appraiser concerning the appointment of an agricultural appraisal advisory board and determining the number of members of that advisory board;
- (23) adhering to laws concerning the preservation, microfilming, destruction, or other disposition of records; and
- (24) adopting and implementing a policy for the temporary replacement of a member of an appraisal review board who violates ex parte communication requirements.

Furthermore, I recognize that the board does not appraise property or review the value of individual properties. I acknowledge that tax rates and tax burdens are determined by applicable taxing jurisdictions, not the appraisal district board of directors.

An application filed before that day is void. All fields of the application **must** be completed unless specifically marked optional.

For an election to be held on a uniform election date, the day of the filing deadline is the 78th day before Election Day.

NEPOTISM LAW

The candidate must sign this statement indicating his awareness of the nepotism law. When a candidate signs the application, it is an acknowledgment that the candidate is aware of the nepotism law. The nepotism prohibitions of chapter 573, Government Code, are summarized below:

No officer may appoint, or vote for or confirm the appointment or employment of any person related within the second degree by affinity (marriage) or the third degree by consanguinity (blood) to the officer, or to any other member of the governing body or court on which the officer serves when the compensation of that person is to be paid out of public funds or fees of office. However, nothing in the law prevents the appointment, voting for, or confirmation of anyone who has been continuously employed in the office or employment for the following period prior to the election or appointment of the officer or member related to the employee in the prohibited degree: six months, if the officer or member is elected at an election other than the general election for state and county officers.

No candidate may take action to influence an employee of the office to which the candidate is seeking election or an employee or officer of the governmental body to which the candidate is seeking election regarding the appointment or employment of a person related to the candidate in a prohibited degree as noted above. This prohibition does not apply to a candidate's actions with respect to a bona fide class or category of employees or prospective employees.

Una solicitud presentada antes de ese día es nula. Todos los campos de la solicitud **deben** completarse a menos que estén específicamente marcados como opcional.

Para una elección que se lleve a cabo en una fecha de elección uniforme, el día de la fecha límite de presentación es el 7^o día antes del día de la elección.

LEY DE NEPOTISMO

El candidato debe firmar esta declaración indicando su conocimiento de la ley del nepotismo. Cuando un candidato firma la solicitud, es un reconocimiento de que el candidato conoce la ley del nepotismo. Las prohibiciones de nepotismo del capítulo 573, Código de Gobierno, se resumen a continuación:

Ningún funcionario puede nombrar, votar o confirmar el nombramiento o empleo de cualquier persona emparentada dentro del segundo grado por afinidad (matrimonio) o del tercer grado por consanguinidad (sangre) con sí mismo, o con cualquier otro miembro del órgano de gobierno o corte en el que se desempeña cuando la compensación de esa persona debe pagarse con fondos públicos o honorarios del cargo. Sin embargo, nada en la ley impide el nombramiento, la votación o la confirmación de cualquier persona que haya estado empleada continuamente en la oficina o el empleo durante el período siguiente antes de la elección o el nombramiento del funcionario o miembro emparentado con el empleado en el grado prohibido: seis meses, si el funcionario o miembro es elegido en una elección que no sea la elección general para funcionarios estatales y del condado.

Ningún candidato puede tomar medidas para influir en un empleado del cargo al que aspira a ser elegido o en un empleado o funcionario del organismo gubernamental al que aspira a ser elegido en relación con el nombramiento o el empleo de una persona emparentada con el candidato en un grado prohibido, tal como se ha indicado anteriormente. Esta prohibición no se aplica a las acciones de un candidato con respecto a una clase o categoría de buena fe de empleados o empleados prospectos.

The Affidavit of Circulator appears at the bottom of each page, but only needs to be completed once for each circulator even if there are multiple pages of voters' signatures.
