This wonderful event's success hinges on the dedication of our volunteers. Volunteers will play a pivotal role by manning the donation shed and spreading cheer by distributing suckers and dog treats to our visitors. They will also graciously collect donations from the public, which ensures the return of our captivating display year after year.

To facilitate their efforts, volunteers will be equipped with reflective vests and provided with hot drinks and all necessary supplies for their shifts. They will be stationed outdoors, so it's important for volunteers to dress appropriately for the weather and wear comfortable shoes or boots, considering the possibility of cold and windy nights. While reflective vests will be available, volunteers are encouraged to bring their own bright-colored or reflective outerwear.

Convenient parking will be provided at the top of the hill next to the Eisenhower statue and flagpoles, specifically designated for volunteers. Additionally, security personnel will be present to assist with managing the entrance and exit facing North Loy Lake Road, ensuring a safe and enjoyable experience for all.

The Holiday Lights Opening Night will be Friday, November 29, 2024 from 5:30pm to 10:00pm and continue every night through Wednesday, December 25, 2024 from 5:30pm to 10:00pm, rain, cold, or shine.

Entrance to the park for the display is very important to control the flow of traffic and keep visitors safe.
